CENTER CITY STOPS

All trains stop at 30th Street Station (30th and Market Streets) Suburban Station (16th Street and JFK Blvd) Jefferson Station (11th and Market Streets)
*Cynwyd Line does not stop at Jefferson Station

Most trains stop at Temple University Station (between 9th + 10th Streets and Berks + Norris Streets)

Service on most lines operates from 5:30am to midnight.

2 LINES · 50 STOPS

The **BROAD STREET LINE** runs N/S and makes 22 stops along Broad Street between Fern Rock in North Philadelphia and the Stadium Complex in South Philadelphia.

The **MARKET-FRANKFORD LINE** runs E/W, making 28 stops between Northeast Philadelphia and West Philadelphia. This line is elevated in some areas.

SINGLE RIDE QUICK TRIPS AVAILABLE FROM FARE KIOSKS

Subways run 24-hours Friday-Sunday and 4:30am to midnight Monday-Thursday.

8 LINES · STOPS AS REQUESTED AT DESIGNATED STATIONS

\$2 (SEPTA KEY CARD) \$2.50 (CASH)
Free transfer to MFL at 30th, 15th and 13th Street Stations and to the BSL at 15th Street Station or anywhere with your SEPTA Key

Trolleys run at least every 15 minutes. Some lines offer 24-hour service.

NORRISTOWN HIGH SPEED LINE

BEST FOR TRAVEL BETWEEN WEST PHILADELPHIA, MAIN LINE, & NORRISTOWN (22 STOPS)
Transfer from MFL AT 69th Street Station

\$2 (SEPTA KEY CARD) \$2.50 (CASH)
Free transfer with your SEPTA Key

MOST STOPS BY REQUEST ONLY
Riders must press a button on the platform to alert the Operator to stop

SEPTA WILL DO THE DRIVING, BUT YOU HAVE THE KEY

SEPTA Key is the quick, seamless way to pay no matter how you ride.

PURCHASE YOUR KEY AT ANY FARE KIOSK OR TICKET OFFICE
There is a one-time fee of \$4.95 which will automatically be refunded as a Travel Wallet credit upon registering your card*.

LOAD YOUR KEY WITH A DAILY, WEEKLY, OR MONTHLY PASS or PAY-AS-YOU-RIDE AT A DISCOUNT WITH SEPTA KEY TRAVEL WALLET

PROTECT YOUR KEY - EASILY!
Lose your card but not your funds when your card is registered.

TAP, RIDE, AND GET ON YOUR WAY!

ON THE BUS AND TROLLEY
Tap your Key on the validator next to the Operator as you board. (Except at 13th, 15th, 19th and 22nd Street on the Trolley. Here you will tap the turnstile.)

ON REGIONAL RAIL
Tap your Key on the platform validator or station turnstile before and after you ride the train. Think "Tap. Ride. Tap."

ON THE SUBWAY
Tap your Key on the validator on the turnstile before you get to the platform.

ON THE NORRISTOWN HIGH SPEED LINE
Tap your Key on the validator next to the Operator as you board - OR - on the turnstile before you get to the platform depending on your departure station.

Note: A SEPTA Key card cannot be used for multiple riders. Each rider needs their own SEPTA Key card to ride.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST TO RIDE?

If you're under 11 years old, it's free! And for everyone else, riding SEPTA is an affordable way to navigate the city. Just as there are many ways to get around on SEPTA, there are also many ways to pay. In addition to the cash listed for each mode, we offer a One Day Convenience Pass that gets you 8 rides across all modes except Regional Rail for \$9 and a One Day Independence Pass gets you 10 rides on all of SEPTA for \$13. Both passes are available on the SEPTA Key card. Visit our website for more fare options. Fares listed good through December 31, 2020.

CAN I RIDE SEPTA TO THE AIRPORT?

Yep! The Airport Line runs every 30 minutes for a quick, hassle-free start to your trip.

HOW DO I KNOW IF MY TRAIN/BUS/TROLLEY IS ON TIME?

The SEPTA App has real-time system updates and transit tracking. You can download the app at the [iTunes Store](https://itunes.apple.com) or [Google Play](https://play.google.com).

CAN I RIDE SEPTA TO NEW YORK CITY?

SEPTA makes it easy (and inexpensive) to get to the Big Apple! Take the Trenton Line to the Trenton Transit Center and transfer to New Jersey Transit's Northeast Corridor train to New York's Penn Station.


